HOW LONG DOES THE TOUR LAST?



There are 5 tours each day, with each tour lasting between 3-4 hours. Ticket times are: 10:00 – 14:00 hrs, 14:10 – 18:00 hrs and 18:10 – 21:00 hrs.

ARE THERE ANY CATERING FACILITIES?

There is a café as you enter the tour to grab a bite to eat.



CAN I BUY ANY SOUVENIRS?

Yes, the pharmacy has been converted into a souvenir shop and there's a professional photographer taking pictures of visitors behind the bar in the Rovers, which you can also buy printed and framed.



WHAT IF I'M IN A WHEELCHAIR?

That's fine, you can still visit the tour, though things may get a bit bumpy if you choose to go across the famous Corrie cobbles!



WHAT TO TAKE WITH YOU?

Take a camera to take snaps of yourself, especially the golden photo of yourself pulling a pint in the Rovers! As always, an umbrella is a good idea just in case the heavens open.



WHAT DO I WEAR?

The tour will take you both indoors and outdoors, so it's wise to dress accordingly. Layers are best as these can be added or taken away as you explore.

Some of the dressing rooms used by the cast, a selection of costumes, interior sets including The Rovers Return and Underworld (the factory). You can then explore the outside sets including a stroll along the famous cobbles.
