

WHAT TO TAKE WITH YOU

It's best to take a rucksack with you as it makes it easier to carry everything, and don't forget to take your camera to capture meeting Mickey & Minnie! Please note that no alcohol is permitted in the park.



WHAT DO I WEAR?

Wear comfy footwear as there can be a lot of walking involved the parks cover 13 square miles! Layers are great, as you can put more on if you get chilly or take them off if the sun is shining. It's also wise to take a poncho or rain mack, these are ideal to wear on water rides!

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CAN I LEAVE MY BAG IN A LOCKER?

If you don't want to carry your bag around with you all day you can pay to leave it in a locker at Guest Relations, this costs \$3, \$7 or \$9 depending on the size of your bag and is located near the turnstile entrance to the park.



CAN I PRE-BOOK TICKETS?

If you are travelling on a coach holiday to Disneyland Paris, your tickets should be included in the cost of the tour, if not they can be brought on the day, but there is likely to be a large queue.

CAN I TAKE PHOTOS?

Refer to your park map to find out Meet & Greet times. You also can pre-book meals with the Disney characters, although be advised that these sell out quickly. To find out more visit the Disneyland website.



WHAT IF I'M IN A WHEELCHAIR?

Disneyland Paris caters for those in wheelchairs. You will need to get a disabled pass when you arrive at the park just remember to take proof of your disability with you.



WHAT CAN I SEE IN THE DISNEYLAND PARK?

The Disneyland Park is split into five lands from Adventureland to Frontierland. For adrenaline junkies take a ride on Space Mountain or Indiana Jones and the Temple of Peril. If you are after something a bit more gentle, look out for children's rides like on 'It's a small world'.



WHAT ARE THE QUEUES LIKE?

Queues in the parks will be longer during school holidays and at weekends. You can download the Disneyland Paris app on your phone which gives up to date wait times on the ride. Also, you can get a fastpass ticket every 2 hours which means you practically skip the queue!



WHAT CAN I SEE IN WALT DISNEY STUDIOS PARK?

Disney Studios Park complex allows visitors to explore and discover the secrets of Disney animation. There are five production zones including the Toon Studio and Backlot, with a number of great attractions including the stunt show.



ARE THERE CATERING FACILITIES?

Catering facilities can be found in both parks - you can also take in picnics, but you will not be allowed to take large amounts into the park. We'd recommend visiting the Diner in the shopping village for a fun experience with waitresses on roller blades!



WHEN IS THE PARADE/FIREWORKS?

To find out locations and times of Fireworks and Parades check your park maps. There are a number of different parades in both parks and the fireworks normally only happen on the weekends.



WHAT MERCHANDISE IS AVAILABLE?

You can buy almost anything in the gift shops located around the park, but just remember they can be pricey. Also, it's worth considering that there are shops in the Disney hotels and shopping Village. Buying gifts here saves you having to carry your purchases around.



WHERE TO STAY?



There are three options when visiting Disney. The first is a Disney Onsite hotel such as the Santa Fe, offering bus services to and from the parks. The second option is an alternative hotel, not directly owned by Disney but still on site. You can also catch the bus to and from the hotel. The third option is an offsite hotel although no bus service is offered, so you would need to wait for your coach to take you to the park or you can make your own way.

CAN I GO INSIDE THE CASTLE?

Unfortunately not, the castle is closed to the public although there are a number of gift shops on the ground floor you can enter.
