WHAT DO I WEAR?

In the Grandstand, ladies must wear formal attire and gentlemen must wear a suit with tie. For the Silver Ring, there is no formal dress code, however race-goers are encouraged to dress smartly.



ASCOT FASHION FAUX-PAS!

No fancy dress, novelty, branded or promotional clothing are allowed on the site. Bare chests and midriffs are not permitted at any time. Hats with a diameter less than 10cm. No strappy or sheer strap dresses or tops.

WHAT IS THERE IN THE SILVER RING ENCLOSURE?

Over 2,000 free seats to view the racing. Big screen TV's. Live music entertainment each day. Lawn area with many bars and food outlets including Pizza Express.



WHAT IS THERE IN THE GRANDSTAND?

Over 1,000 free seats to view the racing. You can watch the Royal Procession & racing action from the lawns. A variety of places to eat, drink and bet. Big screen TV's. Military band performing in the Parade Ring.



ASCOT ESSENTIALS?

The Royal Procession will begin at 2pm so allow yourself plenty of time to get to your admission area. The first race is at 2.30pm with the last race at 5.35pm. Car and coach parks close at 9pm.



SHOULD I BUY A RACE CARD?

This is an essential tool to guide you through the day. It provides details on all of the races, horses and jockeys as well as information about Royal Ascot. It costs £3.50 and is available in all enclosures.

CAN WE BRING A PICNIC?

You can picnic in your car or coach park area. Hot food and barbecues are not permitted. Customers in the Silver Ring can bring a picnic into the enclosure as long as it is in a hamper or coolbox. No drinks, food or snacks are permitted in the Grandstand.



CAN I SEE THE PARADE RING?

Only those who have Grandstand or Royal Enclosure tickets can access the Parade Ring. There is no access available for anyone with Silver Ring Enclosure tickets. Drinks are not permitted.



CAN I BRING A CAMERA?

Yes but pictures must be for personal use only and photography is not allowed in the Parade Ring or on the Royal Enclosure lawns. No flash photography near the horses.



HOW MUCH MONEY DO I NEED FOR BETTING?

The minimum bet at the Tote is £2 and there are 6 races each day. You'll find lots of Tote kiosks and cash machines at the racecourse. Minimum bets with the bookmakers range from £2 to £5.
